The Participant shall effectuate, follow and adhere to the requirements set by the Spotted lanternfly Order of Quarantine and Treatment, as of May 26, 2018, 48 PA.B. 3094 and Quarantine Addendum as of March 16, 2019, 49 PA.B. 1155.

What to do next:

Train your employees

Penn State Extension has developed employee training PowerPoints and included them as a resource in the online permit course. A business representative can download these and use them to train employees.

Distribute permits

Make copies of the permit (top section of this tri-fold) and ensure placement in company vehicles. The permit copy should be kept inside the vehicle with the registration packet or in a permit book (if used).

Document your efforts

Recordkeeping of employee training, inspection of vehicles, control measures taken and shipping records must be maintained for a minimum of two years.
