Quick Reference — Roadside Inspection (ELD Compliant System)

1. Accessing the Roadside inspection page

OR

a. Tap *Roadside Inspection* on the activities page.



b. Select the *Country* you are in.



2. USA – Roadside inspection

- a. Select the *Driver* to include in the report and whether to include the Circle check.
- **b.** Select to either *Transfer* the report *Via Web Services* or *Email* or to *Display the Driver Report* on screen. Note that the correct email is already programmed in the tablet and cannot be entered manually.
- c. Tap *ELD Transfer* (if *Transfer Via Web Services* or *Email* is selected) or *Display* (if *Display Driver Report* is selected). If the connection to the vehicle's gateway is lost, only Display Driver Report can be selected. Additionally, you can contact your dispatch to have them send the report.



2. Canada – Roadside inspection

- a. Select the *Driver* and the report's *Language*, and whether to include the Circle check.
- **b.** Select to either *Transfer* the report *Via Email* or to *Display* the Driver Report on screen. Note that you must enter a valid email when Transfer Via Email is selected.
- c. Tap *Display* (*Display Driver Report* is selected) or *ELD Transfer* (*Transfer Via Email* is selected). If the connection to the vehicle's gateway is lost, only Display Driver Report can be selected. Additionally, you can contact your dispatch to have them send the report.



The Comment/Officer's Badge No field can be used to enter additional information if needed.

Also note that an extra window may appear asking to select the application for opening the report in PDF format on the tablet.



If malfunctions occur with the electonic logbook, you are required to record your hours of service in a paper logbook.

3. Consulting a report on screen

- a. To view the report on the tablet scroll up and down, or swipe the screen to the left and to the right.
- **b.** View the requested information.
- c. Press the tablet's return button to return to the operator's login page.
