
Why is the score changing?

- Netradyne's GreenZone Score has been updated to become a better representation of the correlation between driving behavior and collision rate, based on comprehensive data.
- Provide the ability to paint a fairer and more holistic picture of your safe driving habits and reward you for safe driving behaviors.
- Offer more explainability showing the impact by alert type and the reason for the score.

What will change in the new & improved GreenZone Score version?

- New alerts included: Weaving and Forward Collision Warning
- New DriverStar Streaks included: Safe Speed, Attentive Driving and Safe Following Distance
- A higher deduction will now be in effect for alerts of the same type.
- The Hard Acceleration & Hard Turn alerts now have a higher impact.
- The impact of the Following Distance alert has been slightly reduced.

What are the benefits?



- Easier to understand how your score is impacted by DriverStars and alerts shown directly in the Driver•i Mobile App.
- There are now more ways to get points added to your score with DriverStar Streaks.
- The score is now more comprehensive, fair, and better represents your safety while on the road.


Will my score change?

Yes, for the following reasons:

- A higher deduction will be applied for repeated violations for the same alert type. For example: 10 speeding alerts in a single day will have a higher impact than in the previous version of the GreenZone Score.
- There are more opportunities to get a maximum of 50 points for DriverStars because you have additional Streaks that can help earn these points.
- The impact of the Hard Acceleration and Hard Turn alerts has increased.

How do I ensure that I get the best score?

- Reduce the frequency of the same alert type throughout a trip.
- Increase your awareness of the Hard Acceleration and Hard Turn alerts for your driving and reduce those alerts.
- Practice safe and proactive driving behaviors so you can earn more DriverStars.
- Regularly check your score on the Driver•i Mobile App or with your safety coach/manager so you can better understand what alert types are leading to deductions.
